This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of April 13, 2026, through April 19, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 508 calls for service, 162 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 33 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 18 Property Damage Crashes, 6 Personal Injury Crashes, 4 Hit and Run Crashes, 5 Private Property Crashes, 0 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 0 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

Retail Fraud
2400 S Telegraph Road

On April 18, 2026, the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Target, located at 2400 S Telegraph Road, for a Retail Fraud that just occurred. According to Loss Prevention, the male entered the store at approximately 5:30 p.m. and put multiple items into a basket. The suspect went to self-checkout and scanned the items in their basket but strategically did not scan one pack of Febreze Plug-in air freshener refills and one sweatshirt. The suspect then walked past all other points of purchase and attempted to leave the store when they were stopped by Loss Prevention. The items recovered totaled \$42.99. The suspect was issued a citation for Retail Fraud 3rd Degree and released from the scene.

On April 15, 2026, at approximately 7:30 p.m., Bloomfield Township Officers were dispatched to the Dicks Sporting Goods, located at 2105 S Telegraph Road, for a Retail Fraud that just occurred. It was reported that a female suspect just left the store, stealing 3 Nike tech Pants, totaling \$270.00. The suspect is described as a shorter black female, approximately 25-35 years-of-age, with long black braided hair. She was last seen wearing a black COVID mask, gray winter coat, black sweatpants with white striping on the side and black/white tennis shoes. The suspect left the area in a black Nissan Altima.
