This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of September 1, 2025, through September 7, 2025, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 488 calls for service, 123 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 38 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 24 Property Damage Crashes, 3 Personal Injury Crashes, 1 Hit and Run Crash, 9 Private Property Crashes, 1 Car vs. Deer Crash, and 0 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

Retail Fraud

2501 S. Telegraph Road (Dick's Sporting Goods)

On September 7, 2025, at approximately 7:00 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department responded to a Retail Fraud at 2501 S. Telegraph Road, Dick's Sporting Goods. Store employees observed two white females inside the store with eight children. The females selected multiple pairs of shoes, clothing, and other merchandise totaling over \$820.00 and left the store without paying. The suspects left the area in white GMC Sierra.

Officers located the suspect vehicle and conducted a traffic stop on it. Officers identified the suspects and recovered the stolen merchandise. Officers also discovered several items that were suspected stolen from another retail store outside of the Township. Both females were placed under arrest and transported to the Bloomfield Township Police Department where they were processed. One female was released pending prosecutorial review. The other female had a warrant out of Dallas County, Texas. Dallas County Sheriff's Office was contacted and they advised that they would extradite her to face their charges. That female was transported to the Oakland County Jail to await extradition.

Retail Fraud
2400 S. Telegraph Road (Target)

On September 5, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Target, 2400 S. Telegraph Road, for a Retail Fraud in progress. Loss prevention stated that a male entered the store at approximately 7:20 p.m. and concealed several packs of underwear, a Stanley cup, and Bluetooth head phones totaling \$150.00 into his backpack. The male, described as a skinny black male approximately 16-20 years old with dreads, left the store without paying for the items. Officers canvassed the area but were unable to locate the suspect. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Police Investigation Unit and is currently under investigation. On September 2, 2025, Bloomfield Township Officers were dispatched to the 4000 block of Maple Road to take a report of a Larceny from Automobile. An iPad, MacBook, and two phone chargers are among the items stolen. Evidence Technicians processed the vehicle for evidence.
